This course expands the concepts and methodology presented within the 'Aviation Risk Management' course. It takes the concept of risk management from an introductory stage to a more defined implementation function. Similarly, others working within industry often note that it is difficult to improve their understanding of the topic without formal training. This course allows for both such situations, as it provides the steps to successfully managing risk management systems within business.

Not only does the course build upon the information provided in the introductory course, but it alters the focus to management, and the skills required to be responsible for all or part of a risk management system. Whilst this course can be conducted independently, it is best completed in conjunction with the Introduction to Risk Management course.

This course also covers advanced risk topics such as fatigue risk management systems, hazard management and the implementation of your risk management program. It specifically equips participants with the skills to evaluate the risk documentation and assessments of others.
